

NOTICE TO MEMBERS

As a result of popular demand, the Wilderness Village Board of Directors has decided to renew the three year site program which was due to expire this coming October. The program will partially fund the upcoming 2010 Capital Budget. The first opportunity to apply for this program will be extended to Shareholders. Due to the large number of Members who applied, the sites allocated to the program has been increased to a maximum of 25 sites.

GENERAL TERMS OF THE PROGRAM:

- There will be a total of **25 sites** assigned to this program.
- Occupation of the site shall commence October 2, 2009 and will end on October 1, 2012.
- Acceptance of applications will begin immediately. Shareholders will have the first opportunity to apply until August 1, 2009, then applications will be accepted from non-Shareholders.
- Once 25 applications are received, any additional applicants will be kept on a waiting list in the event a Member exits the program.
- Sites will not be assigned until September 1, 2009.
- A cheque or credit card number must accompany the application and will be processed once the application is approved. PLEASE NOTE: A 2% processing fee is charged when paying by credit card on amounts over \$2,000.00.
- Eligible sites assigned to this program are listed below (similar to the Adopt-a-site Program). Please note that only a certain percentage of the sites on any particular street will be assigned.
- Rules and Regulations pertaining to this program will accompany the application form.

PRICE: \$6825.00 (Including GST)

OTHER: The 180 day usage rule will apply (Member's Handbook). No Member will be entitled to camp over 180 nights each year during the period of this program. Applicants who choose sites outside of the Winter grid may not use their site for Winter camping and will be required to move if they intend to Winter camp. Please check with the office to see whether your site choice is in or out of the Winter grid.

THREE YEAR SITE PROGRAM (2009-2012) PROGRAM RULES AND GUIDELINES

1. Applications may be sent by Email, Canada Post, FAX, or in person. A check or credit card number must accompany the application. Nothing will be processed until the application has been accepted and a site assigned. **PLEASE NOTE: A 2% processing fee is charged when paying by credit card on amounts over \$2,000.00.**
2. All participants are required to keep their sites neat and tidy including mowing the lawn if necessary. Portable structures such as tents and dining shelters must be moved regularly to prevent killing the grass. Nothing may be tied to the trees.
3. Members who participated in the last program are not automatically guaranteed a site in this program. The selection process will be fair to all participants by assigning sites on a draw basis from the first 25 applications received. **There will be 20 sites allocated to the 2009 - 2012 program. The cost will be \$6825.00 including GST.**
4. **Applications may be submitted anytime prior to the deadline, which will be 4 PM, August 31, 2009. Applicants must indicate their preference of site choices in descending order on the application form. In the event there are more applicants than sites available, a cancellation (waiting) list will be kept.**
5. A draw will be performed on September 1, 2009 out of the first 25 applications received. Applicants will be assigned their sites in the descending order of their choice as listed on their application form and based upon the remaining eligible sites.
6. Switching of sites between participants can only take place with the consent of all parties involved and the approval of the umpire in charge of the program. No participant will be required to trade site with another Member.
7. Shareholding Members will have the first opportunity to participate in this program. Should all 20 sites not be taken after the Shareholder's have had an opportunity to apply, non-Shareholding Members may apply.
8. The program duration extends from October 2, 2009 to October 1, 2012. At the conclusion of the program all RV units must be immediately removed from the site. Participants wishing to Winter Camp will be required to choose their sites within the Winter Camping grid or move their unit into the grid for Winter.
9. An umpire will be appointed by the Board to oversee the Three Year Site Program. All WVCA rules and regulations will still apply, although they will be subject to the interpretation and determination of the umpire, who will address any issues involving site usage. The 24 and 72 hour site absentee rule will not apply to participants. Members are reminded that according to our rules, only one primary RV unit and one tent are permitted on a site, with the tent having to be moved frequently to avoid damaging the grass. The maximum number of persons permitted to camp on the site is eight (as per WVCA rules).
10. Three year sites are intended for participating Member's use only. No guest may occupy the site without the Member present unless prior approval is received from the Park management

(additional camping fee will apply). There will be a nightly guest fee applied for any additional RV unit on site.

11. No Three Year Sites will be assigned directly beside each other.

NOTE: There will no more than ten (10) percent of the total sites on any particular street assigned to the Three Year Program. Once this number is assigned, other participating Members will need to choose an alternative site.
